When designing a bathroom, the trio behind Three Birds Renovations prioritises tucking the toilet out of view and, where possible, creating a feature of the bath. In this remodel, there was space to do both, with the toilet now hidden behind the vanity and the freestanding bath in full view. “We’ve made the bath the hero of the room, so it sits in full view of the entry with a beautiful artwork by Tahnee Kelland hanging above it,” says Lana Taylor of Three Birds Renovations. Recessing the shower into an alcove with a rendered wall meant there was no need for a glass screen, and positioning it near the window provides excellent natural light and ventilation. Dulux Acratex was applied instead of tiles to give a softer, smoother, yet still textural, finish. The bathroom’s colour scheme includes peach and apricot, teamed with terracotta-look subway tiles on the floor, brushed bronze tapware and a timber vanity. All this gives the room an “earthy, grounded feel” that the owners simply love.
